

Tächa – the Band

Tächa is an expression of the Bernese Alps for alpine chough. The band's name is also a symbol for their music – which is deeply rooted in the traditional music of Switzerland but also spreads its musical wings to far corners of the world. Tächa are Ueli von Allmen (guitar, vocals), Pedi “Shanti” Sterchi (percussion), Thomas Kupper (double bass, vocals) and Bruno Raemy (Swiss button accordion).
