

For the presentation of his photographs, Jost von Allmen uses a notebook with an internationally customized power supply (100-240 volts and 50-60 Hz). He will bring along his own power supply adapter.

The photographs will be shown synchronically to the music via a notebook with an ordinary VGA connection for the picture signal. Please note that the pictures will not be transmitted via a CD or DVD. Required beamer resolution should at least be XGA (1024 x 768 Pixels), preferably SXGA (1400 x 1050 Pixels).

Beamer minimum brightness: 2500 Lumen, preferably 3000 Lumen or more. The beamer can be fixed (e.g. on the ceiling) of a room. For his notebook Jost von Allmen requires a desk on the stage, directly in front of the stage or, at least, with direct view of the band, as he is displaying his photographs live to the music. The picture screen should be placed close to the musicians (on top or on the side).

A large screen would be very welcome (3x4.5m or bigger, depending on the size of the auditorium and the audience expected). The aspect ratio of the photographs is always 2:3. Jost von Allmen shows his photographs only in landscape format (horizontally).

During the slide show the hall lights should be dimmed or off. The stage lights should only show the musicians (using dimmable spots in various colours).
